What the Right to be Forgotten is for CPE



- An opportunity for ending financial discrimination
- Prioritising the holistic well-being of patients beyond just their medical treatment
- A European framework to avoid inequalities
- Data availability
- Ceiling of 5 yrs after the end of cancer treatment
- A code of conduct more restrictive than a law



CPE Role in The Right to be Forgotten

- Collaborated with lawmakers in Italy
- Supported Dr Meunier in her advocacy at EU Level for the inclusion of the RTBF in the EBCP
